

BASLOW & BUBNELL NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH CCTV CONSULTATION

During the month of May 2022 the Baslow & Bubnell Neighbourhood Watch will run a village wide consultation to ascertain if residents and businesses are still in support of a CCTV system for the village.

Any such CCTV cameras will be positioned on roads on the very outskirts of the village, they will not intrude upon any public, private areas or premises.

The data will only be viewed retrospectively to assist with police enquiries.

The scheme will comply with all necessary government guidance.

Baslow & Bubnell Neighbourhood Watch has now acquired the funding and the scheme will be of no cost to residents or the Parish Council.

There are similar schemes up and running in Hathersage and Curbar. In 2021 a pilot cctv scheme was held and proved successful in that due to images captured on the cctv, the police were able to identify suspects in two robberies and a high value burglary and theft.

You will soon receive a voting slip regarding this consultation at your home address or business premises.

All replies will be treated with the utmost confidentiality in line with GDPR regulations, and the results and process will be accredited by independent adjudicators.
