Are you one of the households with a Feed in Tariff?

Although you will still be being paid for both generation and export, in this talk and discussion you can learn how you can increase your generation; including what changes you can make to your system and might want to make; whether to install a battery and how to go about that; whether you should replace or upgrade your panels; and how to maintain your panels.

Also, are you better sticking with the 50% deemed export or getting your exported power metered; is the income taxable; whether you can you change your supplier; verification visits; and any other questions you may have.

The Feed in Tariff scheme was active from 1st April 2010 and closed on 31st March 2019. There have been a lot of changes since then so also come to our next meeting on **Tuesday 1st July 2025 7pm-8.45pm** to find out about installing solar now.
